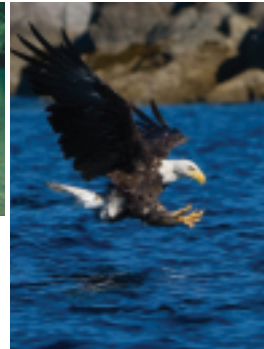

King Pacific Lodge, a Rosewood Resort, is one of the world's most luxurious wilderness lodges. Operating from May to September and intimate in size with just 17 rooms and suites, the Lodge floats in a sheltered harbour along the shores of Princess Royal Island, amid the Great Bear Rainforest of coastal British Columbia, Canada. Only accessible by boat or seaplane, guests fly into Vancouver and take a short flight to Bella Bella, followed by a floatplane right down to the Lodge (2.5 hours in total).

- **True Wilderness** - King Pacific Lodge immerses guests in an unparalleled wilderness experience. The Great Bear Rainforest surrounding the Lodge is the largest remaining tract of temperate rainforest in the world and is home to an incredible variety of plants and trees, not to mention an abundance of wildlife.
 - **Eco-friendly wilderness tourism** - From the outset, a first priority for King Pacific's President, Michael Uehara and Owner Joe Morita of Japan was to create a lodge that would be a viable and sustainable tourism model. They forged a complementary relationship with the land, the ocean and the Gitga'at, the First Nations people who have been stewards of the Great Bear Rainforest for centuries.
 - **Life experiences** - Guests don't just participate in activities at the Lodge, they are immersed in a series of experiences and an ongoing process of discovery about nature and themselves. Guests may tailor their stay to suit personal interests and passions by choosing from different adventures, excursions and sports
- each day - hiking, sea kayaking, whale watching, wildlife viewing, star gazing, floatplane tours, and fishing - saltwater trolling, fly and remote freshwater heli fly-fishing.
- **Wildlife** - The region is home to the rare cream-coloured Kermode Bear - also known as the 'Spirit Bear' and local Gitga'at guides lead bear-viewing searches during September. Wildlife viewing is a must: guests may see orcas and humpback whales, black bears, seals, sea lions, sea otters and eagles.
 - **The Spa** - The Lodge's spa offers a sophisticated experience for guests in the wild. The serene treatment rooms are built of local fir with driftwood accents, or guests can enjoy treatments in the privacy of their room or suite.
 - **Fine Dining** - The Lodge delivers an elegant wilderness dining experience featuring the finest organic ingredients, local seafood and award winning wines.
