



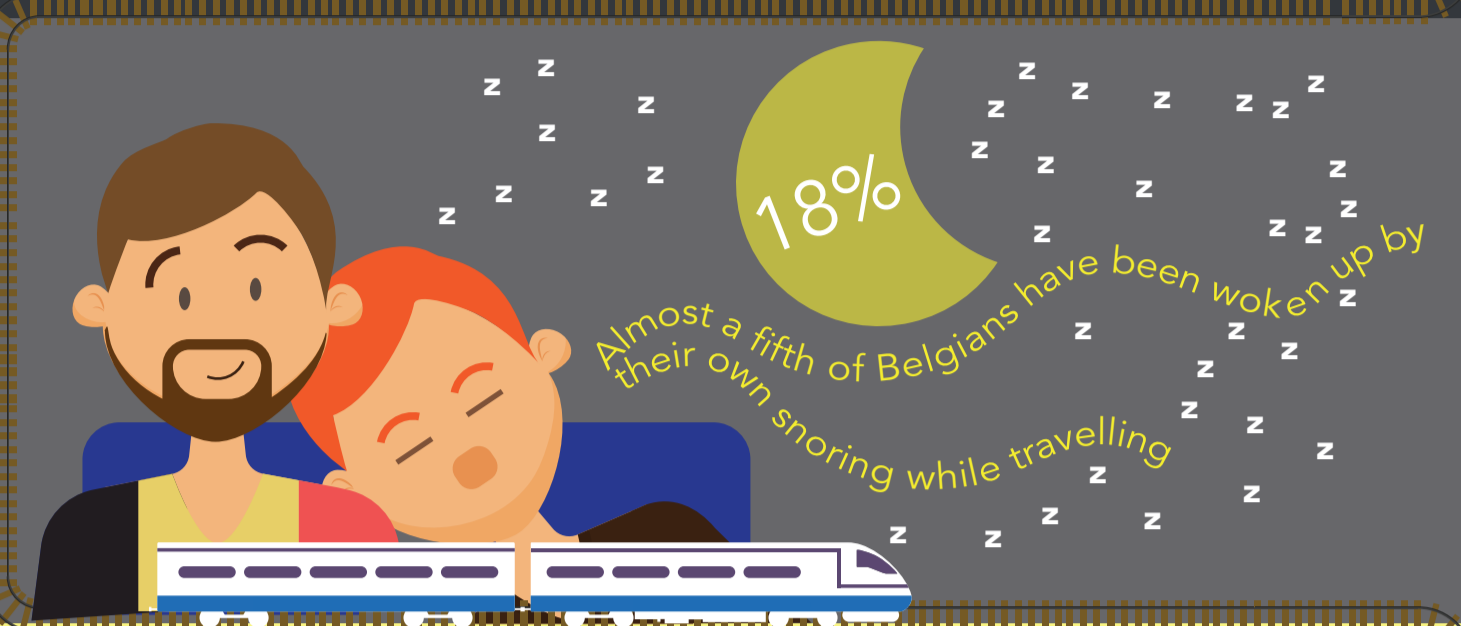

18% Almost a fifth of Belgians have been woken up by their own snoring while travelling

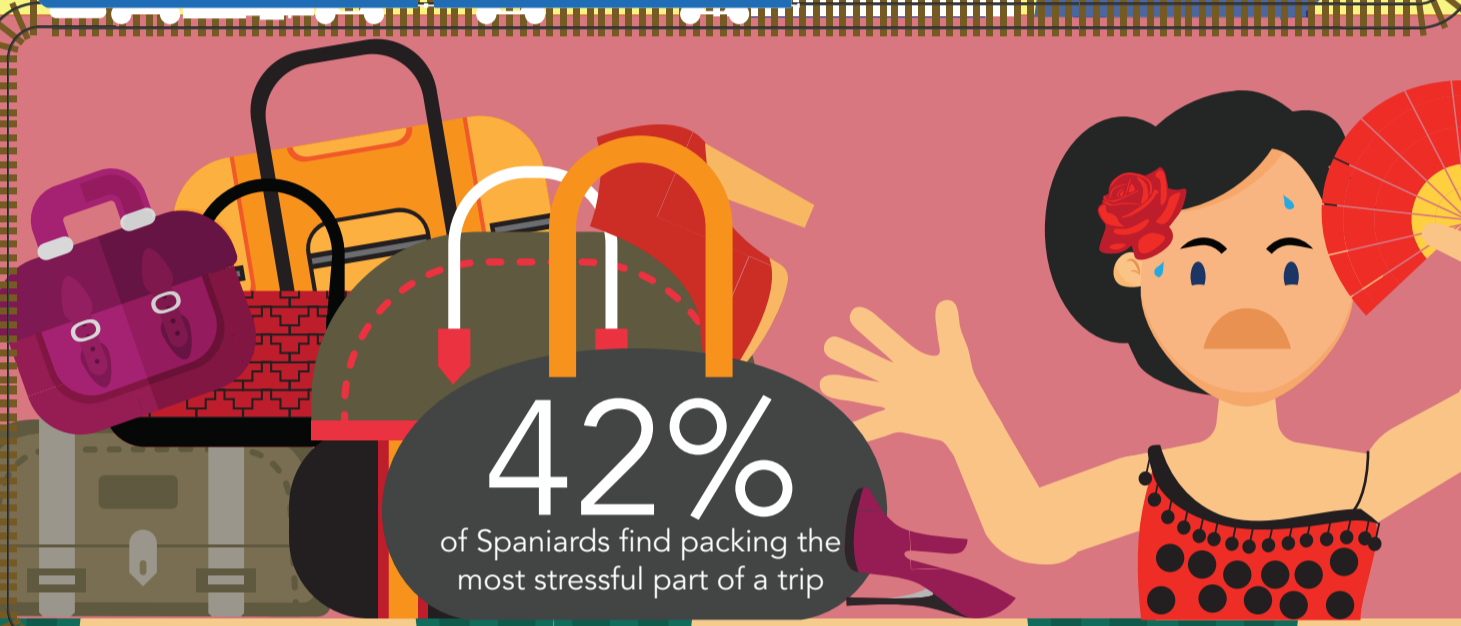


Nearly a quarter of German travellers said the thing that annoyed them the most when travelling was loud phone conversations

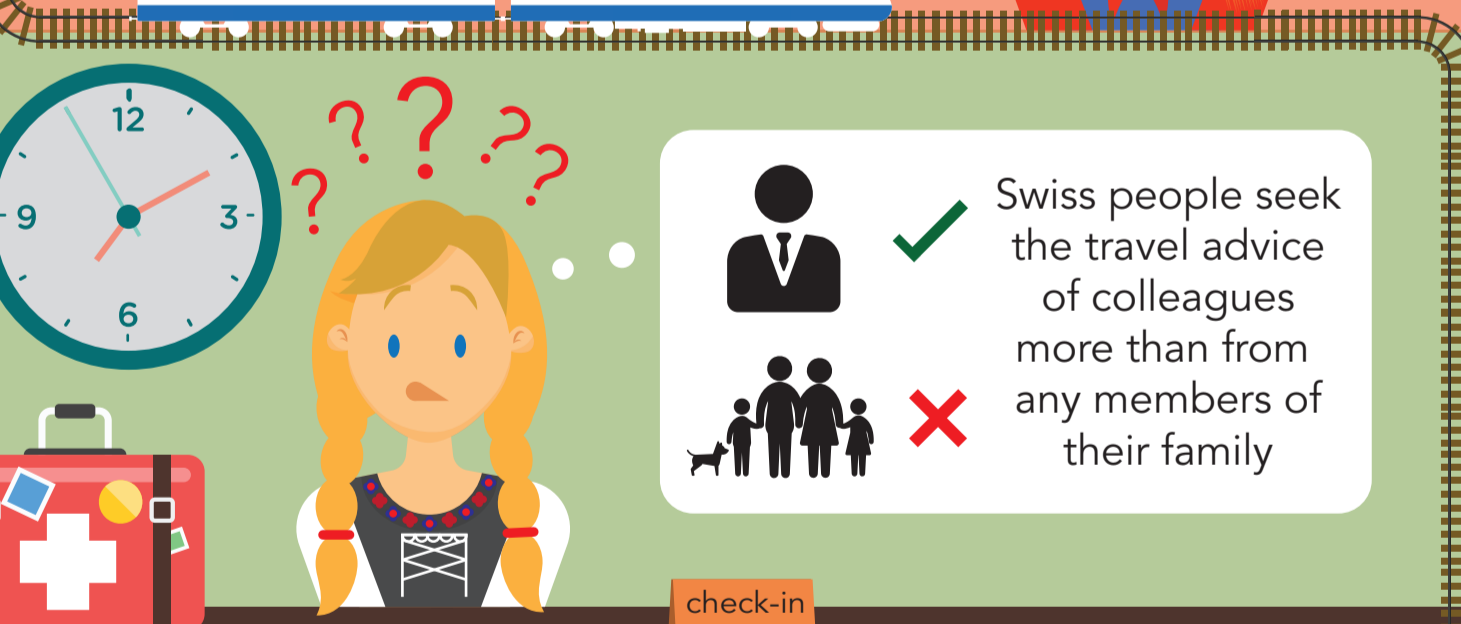
